Make-Up/Hair Information

Make-up: All dancers should wear basic make-up for pictures, dress rehearsal and recital day. Please see below for a list of required make-up for your dancer's level. Please no blue, purple, pink, or green eye shadow. All dancers need to wear natural colors.

Dancers in a Combo Class (Mostly dancers who are 7 and younger.)

Light Blush (Pink)

Light Lipstick (Pink or Light Red)

Light Eye Shadow in neutral colors (Brown, White, Tan, Silver)

Dancers 8 and older:

Blush

Red Lipstick

Neutral Eye Shadow (Brown, White, Tan, Silver)

Black Mascara

Light eyeliner (optional)

Hair: Hair must be secured in the hairstyle listed below. If your hair is shorter than shoulder length you may wear it half-up/half-down with the hair piece secured in the same location as your group. Classes with curly hairstyles need to use a curling iron or rollers. Tighter curls are better for a stage performance. Make sure you use plenty of hairspray or gel so you have no fly-away hair on-stage or in pictures!

Tippy Toes, Combo, and Dance Jam – Half-Up/Half-Down Curly.

All Ballet Classes – Ballet Bun with a hair colored hairnet and bobby pins.

Level I Classes – High Curly Pony Tail

Level II and Up Classes – Low Straight Ponytail, parted in the center of the head.

Other: Students may not wear jewelry during the performance (with the exception of small studded earrings that are not noticeable onstage). If students wish to wear jewelry for their individual pictures they may, but dancers must look uniform for all performances.

Tights are not meant to be worn with underwear; they have a cotton crotch which serves as underwear. Underwear should not be sticking out of dance costumes. If your dancer doesn't feel comfortable going without it, they may wear nude colored dance underwear (which can be purchased only at a dance store). Please remember that dancers do not wear underwear when they perform and this is a much easier habit to develop when your dancer is young.

We also sell nude leotards for the purpose of changing backstage. All dancers with costume changes should have a nude leotard.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsal – Thursday, June 11

Please note the time below for your dress rehearsal as dress rehearsal is mandatory. Please arrive early in costume ready to perform. You do not need to have full stage make-up or the correct hair style for dress rehearsal but it is a good time to practice and see exactly how your dancer will look on-stage. Please allow plenty of time to find the location if you have not been there before. Please do not bring any extra guests to dress rehearsal. When you arrive please wait with your dancer in the auditorium until their group is called.

We will release each group to their parent as soon as their rehearsal is over. In order to stay on-schedule, each group usually only rehearses one time.

*Group classes only. Solos/Duets do not participate in the Dress Rehearsal.

Ticket Information

Everyone aged 3 and over will need their own seat and a ticket to enter the auditorium. Children 2 and under may sit on a parent's lap. Each family gets 2 tickets to each show that they are performing in with the paid Show Fee (**Use Code: ShowFee26**). Dancers coming to watch siblings perform also get a free ticket. The following codes will provide a credit for **both** the included tickets, as well as any sibling ticket (you can only use one code). For Tickets + 1 Sibling use code: **LLDSibling** For Tickets + 2 Siblings use code: **LLDSibling2**

Tickets are \$18 pre-sale. Families do not need to purchase additional tickets for the 7pm show time. Any tickets from 12pm or 4pm show times will grant entry to the 7pm show time and those seats are not assigned.

Show Day

Dancers should arrive in full make-up and costume 30 minutes before their show time. When you arrive, you will check your dancer in with our backstage coordinator at the holding room door. Please keep in mind that we cannot have any adults or siblings backstage in the holding area.

In order to facilitate a successful day, your child will not be allowed to sit with you or leave the performance early. Each show should run approximately 2 hours. When you drop-off your

dancer please make sure their dance shoes are already on and only send a water bottle labeled with their name. Please do not send any extra items. If your dancer has a costume change, please label everything with their name.

AUDIENCE ETIQUETTE

Along with teaching your children to dance, it is our goal to allow them to participate in the process of presenting a live performance such as the Recital. To encourage the best possible performance from your child, it is important to model being a great audience member. Please remind your family and friends of the following guidelines for being a great audience member for a live dance performance.

-When you are watching a live performance, the people on stage can hear and see you. Please do not call out your child's name or wave to them. It will make it difficult for them to concentrate on their performance.

-Please turn all cell phones to vibrate and answer calls outside of the theater. Please set device screens to the lowest light level. Please enter and exit the theater between dances and not during.

-If you are videotaping your child, please be mindful of those around you as their child may also be on stage. You may videotape your child from your seat only so long as your camera does not obstruct the view of another audience member or our videographer. If you are using a device to record, the screen must be dimmed and held no higher than your head.

-Flash photography is not allowed during the performance as it can be dangerous to our performers. The flash of a camera will momentarily blind the performer and is very distracting to them. Please make sure that your party understands the seriousness of this issue and that all flashes must be turned off before the recital begins.

-Please make sure that everyone in your party (with the exception of children under 3) has a ticket!
